#### 3. Announcements, Committee Reports and Special Guests

- a. Officer Paul Van Handel: compliment for Alderman Galvin, who acted upon maintenance concerns on 600 block of S. Madison. Some discussion also of greater number of homeless/intoxicated in the streets. Nextdoor Astor blogs reported people going through unlocked cars.
- b. Alderman Bill Galvin: distributed maps that show the present parking restrictions, and proposed changes from residential parking by permit to 2 hr. parking, 7 AM-7PM Mon.-Fri. North of Porlier stays the same. The proposed changes would allow people to park a few blocks away from Aldo Leopold School, and drop their kids off. Would still be congested around Aldo Leopold. Have always been able to get daytime parking permits, if called in, for a month or two at a time. Concerns expressed about allowing parking on Quincy St. near Aldo.
- This proposal would go to Committee (Bike pad and Traffic, 4:30 PM Mon. Aug. 27), for a 90 day trial. After the 90 days, then could go to Council. ANA will try to get this out on our Facebook and website.
- c. Katie Boat Sculptures and Movie Night: will need to hire somebody to repair the boat sculptures.

Movie night is Wed. August 29. Pastor Schleis will do the popcorn, starting at 7:15 PM. Show the movie about 8:00 PM. \$150 will be paid to Criterion for copy write issues.

- d. Pastor Schleis Back to School Pot Luck Tues. Sept. 04 6 PM, St. James Park. Devin Sommers is hired to provide food (hamburgers, utensils, potato salad, etc.) Free hot dogs provided by American Foods.
- e. Ron for Deby If Homes Could Talk, Sat. Sept. 15: Ron shared a list of homes contributing, and could use one or two more. Ron also showed a write-up poster, as an example that could be used.
- f. Ron Astor Neighborhood Sign (on Monroe Ave.) clean up: might have some volunteers, instead of paying. ANA Board members asked to give an hour to help.
- g. Lampposts (Cheryl): have 7 on the list, could do one or two more. Concern that a post was removed from the public Facebook page.
