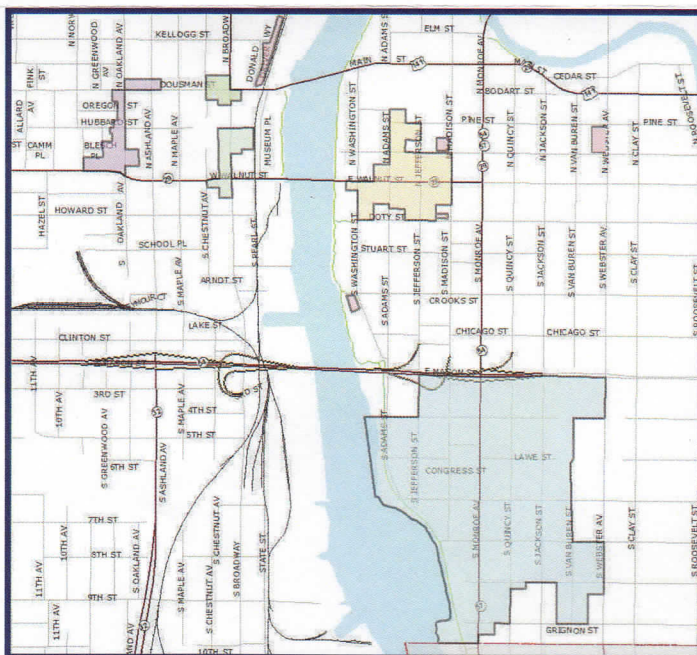



Historic Preservation Ordinance Updates

The City of Green Bay's Department of Community and Economic Development staff and the Historic Preservation Commission have been working to revise our existing Historic Preservation ordinance. The City is seeking Certified Local Government (CLG) status, which allows the City to apply for additional funding for historic surveys, educational materials, events, and other grant-sponsored activities. To become a CLG, the City needs a *binding* design review as part of our ordinance, versus our existing *advisory* review.

With this change, we will also be reforming as a new commission, the **Landmarks Commission**. This Commission would be made of professionals in the field, as well as citizens who live in historic properties. Along with the commission change, the City would also start offering **staff reviews**, negating the need to wait for a commission meeting. The proposed changes would create the least-restrictive ordinance possible to allow for CLG status, and would be more effective than our current process.

Please join our staff as we present the ordinance changes, walk property owners through the process, and explain the benefits of the new ordinance to you. The City looks forward to continuing historic preservation efforts throughout our historic city!
