**4. Agenda Items:**

- a) **GBN Mini-grant application:** ANA's proposal to have a mural(s) done underneath the Monroe Ave. /e. Mason St. overpass was originally denied, due to lack of specific design. We'll resubmit by July 01, with a RFP (Request For Proposals) sought from local artists for designs.
- b) **Annual meeting and monthly meeting plans:** The annual meeting has been posted from April, due to COVID 19 concerns. We'll work toward the possibility of having an outdoor meeting from the St. James band shell, perhaps in August. The ANA Board will meet via Zoom as long as necessary, and will work to post Zoom info for neighbors to join us in the monthly Board meetings.
- c) **City Band concerts:** The city band might have a shortened concert season later this summer, maybe by mid July. If so, the ANA will provide free popcorn and bottled water for the concerts.
- d) **Spring plantings:** It was noted that the ANA sign are on S. Monroe Ave. is quite overgrown. Ron will contact volunteers to cut down the overgrowth, rototill the area, and lay down a layer of mulch, before we consider what kind of low-maintenance plants might work there.  
*M/S/C to spend up to \$100 on mulch.*
- e) **If Homes Could Talk:** Normally about the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of September. If it's held, and due to COVID 19 concerns, would probably be a walking tour, not going inside the homes. There was discussion about putting together, and selling via digital download, a digital guide for the homes.
